Russell, Natalie. <b><i>Moon Rabbit</i></b> . Viking, 2009. A city rabbit befriends a country rabbit, but soon she misses her home and all of its cafes, parks, and bright lights.	Elliott, David. <b><i>On the Farm</i></b> . Candlewick, 2008. Animals of the farmyard, including a goat, a cow, a rooster, bees, and bunnies, are presented in verse accompanied by woodcut and watercolor illustrations.	Seuss, Dr. <b><i>One Fish Two Fish, Red Fish Blue Fish</i></b> . Little poems about fantastical creatures. Humerous.
Cronin, Doren. <b><i>Click, Clack, Splish, Splash: A Counting Adventure</i></b> . While farmer brown sleeps some of the animals experience fishing!	Houblon, Marie. <b><i>A World of Colors</i></b> . Beautiful photographs. This was published by National Geographic.	Sendak, Maurice <b><i>Where the Wild Things Are</i></b> , Won many awards. After being put to bed without supper by his mother, Max imagines sailing off to where the wild things are, becoming the king of all wild things and eventually returning to his own room where hot supper is waiting for him.

Look through the book with your child and talk about the pictures. As you read, have children point to words and make the sounds of the letters. After reading each book your student will draw a picture of the main character or event. Help them write the title and author at the top of each page.
